Anne Friederike Greuner is concertmaster of the philharmonic state orchestra Mainz. She is also an enthusiastic chamber musician, a committed teacher and an active doctoral student at the HfM Saarbrücken (supervised by Prof. Dr. Dartsch).

The violinist completed her bachelor's degree at the HfMT Hamburg with Prof. Christoph Schickedanz with distinction. After her debut with the Hamburg Camerata in 2014, she excelled at many competitions in Germany and abroad and deepened her musical possibilities thanks to a DAAD scholarship during her master's studies at the Salzburg Mozarteum.

Through courses with personalities such as Ingolf Turban, Shmuel Ashkenasi, Ulf Hoelscher, Tanja Becker-Bender, William Coleman and Meesun Hong, she constantly gained new artistic impulses.
